The unreached are cultural and ethnic groups without a self-sustaining witness to the gospel in their own cultures.

From business and education to healthcare, agriculture, the arts, and more, our 3,000 global members use their diverse gifts and experience to serve in needy communities. As they do, they see God transform lives across cultures and people groups everywhere.

Reaching the Unreached

Whether in sprawling cities or rural villages, our teams make their homes in unreached contexts and learn new languages. They use innovative and creative means to build relationships and make disciples. They introduce people to the Bible and share the gospel in culturally understandable ways.

Working Together

We work in partnership with the local church. Each missionary is commissioned by a sending church. The sacrificial gifts of friends, family, and churches provide financial support. This makes it possible for cross-cultural missionaries to work alongside local believers with a heart to see disciples making disciples, worldwide.

My Sisters' Kids is a nonprofit program dedicated to supporting kids who are grieving the death of a loved-one. We provide a safe place where children, teens, young adults and their families can share their experiences. Our groups meet the second and fourth Thursday of the month. Our trained volunteer facilitators use *The Dougy Center* model for peer-support groups, which has proven successful in hundreds of locations across the country.

Because each child grieves in his or her own way, and often grieves in cycles, our groups are open-ended, meaning that children can participate for as long as they want. Studies have shown over and over again that offering a safe, judgment-free outlet for grief can lower the risks for later life occurrences of isolation, loneliness, social anxiety, depression, suicide, drug or alcohol abuse, teen pregnancy and incarceration.

All of our services are free of charge.
